

How does it work in my classroom?


- · Write your name on the classroom door poster and hang it outside your room to welcome students!
- · Hang up the Awesome Friendly Good Deed tracker poster where students can see it, and encourage your class to start thinking about the different ways they can be Awesome and Friendly to their peers.
- · Use the pre-filled Awesome Friendly Deed column headers as inspiration to write personalized suggestions for your classroom!
- Help students use the Awesome Friendly Good Deed tracker poster to acknowledge specific moments when they see their classmates being Awesome and Friendly. Students recognize one another by coloring in a star under the specific header with the Awesome Friendly deed they witnessed.
- · When a student does something Awesome or Friendly, award him or her with an Awesome Friendly Person certificate, which you can reproduce from this digital kit. Encourage kids to hand out these certificates to their classmates or even school staff members like a secretary or janitor.
- Use the bookmarks as rewards for students who nominate Awesome Friendly People.
- · When all the stars on the poster are colored in, have an official Awesome Friendly Celebration of your choosing!

Use the below tips and suggestions to extend your Awesome Friendly Classroom experience beyond the items in this starter kit!

Create a Classroom Moments of Awesome Box to track when you notice students doing Awesome or Friendly deeds that are not on the tracker grid.

- · Find a suitable box in your school. The box should be built so that paper nominations can be easily dropped in, but not easily removed.
- Have the students in your class help decorate or sign the box.
- · Decide on a goal of additional good deeds for the classroom as a whole that are different from the Awesome Friendly Good Deed tracker poster, like volunteering as a group, planting a tree together, etc.
- Drop a note in the box every time your classroom does something Awesome or Friendly.
- · At the end of the year, count how many additional Awesome and Friendly deeds your classroom has achieved!

Recognize Awesome Friendly Students from throughout the school or district!

• Take a moment to celebrate students who go above and beyond! Have your principal or guidance counselor ask teachers for recommendations and honor a selection of Awesome Friendly students during a time when the school is gathered together. Consider ways to make your Awesome Friendly Celebrations unique! Blow bubbles, play music, or involve the nominating teachers in a meaningful way. Be sure to personalize a reproducible Awesome Friendly Person certificate for each recipient!

Work with your school's librarian to make reading fun!

- · Challenge students to keep track of how many books they've read with the checklist on the back of the bookmarks. Offer a prize for students who read them all!
- Use the themes in the books, such as sports in Diary of a Wimpy Kid: Big Shot and spooky stories in Rowley Jefferson's Awesome Friendly Spooky Stories, to interest students who may not have a read a Diary of a Wimpy Kid or Awesome Friendly book.

Encourage students to be Awesome and Friendly outside the classroom!

 Reproduce and distribute the Your Awesome Friendly Good Deeds—Outside the Classroom! sheet included in this digital kit so that students can practice being Awesome and Friendly at home or in their communities. Challenge students to complete the deeds listed (and even come up with some of their own!). Reward students who return their completed worksheet.
